Muis Support for Persons with Special Needs

On 1 Feb 2019, Muis and SNTC signed a memorandum of understanding (MOU) for the **Muis Support for Persons with Special Needs Scheme**, a joint partnership to provide financial support for Muslim families having dependents with special needs.

Muis will sponsor up to \$10,000 for each beneficiary who is under the scheme to set up an SNTC trust account, of which \$5,000 will cover the initial deposit to set up the trust, and subsequently up to \$5,000 on a matching contribution basis.

With the generous support from Muis, more low- to middle-income Muslim families are able to set up an SNTC trust as a legal safeguard for their dependants.

A Peace of Mind

Madam Lenny, who has a daughter with intellectual disability, was relieved to set up an SNTC trust with the Muis sponsorship. With a family of five, Madam Lenny and her husband originally faced difficulties raising the initial deposit of \$5,000 to set up the trust.

Besides the trust, SNTC's Case Managers also helped Madam Lenny develop a care plan that details long-term care arrangements for her daughter, and will continue to conduct reviews with the family regularly.

"Previously I was struggling to save up to set up the [trust]. Now, I will put the savings that I have to good use, such as for insurance policies," said Madam Lenny.

As SNTC steps up efforts in reaching out to the community, we have been actively involved in several purposeful events to raise awareness of the importance of future planning.



World Down Syndrome Day 2019

On 16 March, SNTC took part in World Down Syndrome Day 2019 organised by Down Syndrome Association. The event was buzzing with fun-filled activities for participants. SNTC held a booth to provide public education about our services and also joined in the cheery atmosphere by giving out handmade origami.



Let's Play! Event Series

We were also delighted to partake in Let's Play! Events – a series of inclusive play events in support of the See the True Me campaign. Awareness booths by SNTC were set up at PAssion WaVe @ Pasir Ris and Bedok Reservoir on 4 May and 1 June respectively.



World Health Day 2019

SNTC joined various community groups at West Coast Community Club to celebrate *World Health Day* on 7 April. More than 600 people registered and SNTC was invited to deliver a talk on SNTC trust services and deputyship - a good way to bring greater awareness about our services to the community.



Talk for Members of Life Insurance Association

With support from Life Insurance Association (LIA), SNTC conducted a talk on our services to over 70 agents and advisors. A small regular premium paid for insurance could provide a significant financial resource for beneficiaries' trust accounts to provide for their future care needs. The talk to raise awareness among participants was held at Enabling Village on 12 April and it was well-received.
